CAN YOU HELP HAPPYCATS BY FOSTERING A CAT?

HappyCats Rescue™ uses a network of wonderful foster carers who care for their foster cats in their own homes. With more foster homes we can help more cats and kittens find their new forever homes.

Can you help us, please? Even if you can only foster now and again, it all helps.

HappyCats continually has to make difficult decisions and turn away cats that could otherwise be helped—solely due to lack of foster space.

Ideally, you will be in, or close to, Bordon. This is to keep travelling for the cats, and you, to a minimum. Our vets are in Bordon, so you must be able to get them there for veterinary checks and treatments. All vets bills for foster cats are met by HappyCats Rescue. You MUST be able to keep your foster cats separately from all other animals—so they will need their own room—and they must remain inside at all times. All food and litter can be supplied to a fosterer. You supply the love.

You will have a "foster buddy" (who is an established foster carer for the Rescue) to chat to about all things foster cats so you won't be on your own. You are also welcome to chat with and visit a "foster buddy" to see how they have their foster cats set up.

We are looking forward to seeing these on



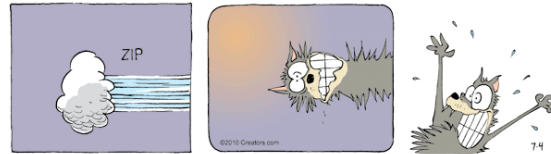
cars when we are out and about.

Guy Fawkes Night bring with them noises and flashing lights that can be frightening for all animals.



Cats, as well as other pets, simply cannot comprehend what is happening; what is causing the flashing lights and what is causing the louds bangs.

You can help your pets by taking a number of precautions prior to these events.

Close all doors and windows as this will reduce some of the noise.

If you can use a room that is further away from noise—why not move your cat into the room for the short term.

Cat Pheromones such a Feliway (other types also available) can help your cat to remain calm(er). **Natural Remedies** such as catnip and valerian toys and sprays may help in similar manner to pheromones.

Remember to check where your cat (and other pets) are **before you open the door** to visitors to prevent them escaping unexpectedly.

Keep your pet in after dark (you may also wish to do this during daylight hours) to reduce the risk of a sudden noise frightening your pet and them running away.

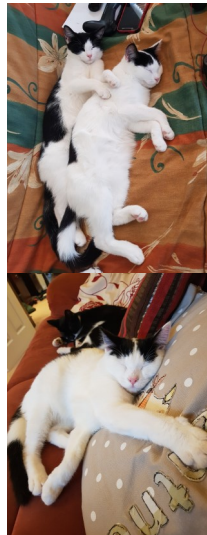


HAPPY ENDINGS STORY— CHUCK, SERENA AND BAILEY (NOW PLUTO, POPPY AND PIPPA)

We came to HappyCats Rescue™ via a friend. We had lost our previous cat to old age (she was 20 years old) in the January and by March we felt ready to adopt again. The house was far too quiet without a cat!. We decided to look at kittens - and, well, we have 3 times the trouble now!

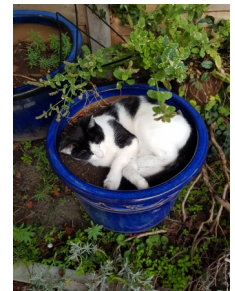


We met Bailey (now Pippa), Serena (now Poppy) and Chuck (now Pluto) and felt they would fit in well with our busy household and children. One successful homecheck later and we brought them home. They were 12 weeks old when we adopted them and they are just over 6 months old now.



Our children absolutely adore them and have now become much more confident around young animals. They have a rota for feeding them and it means both the cats and the children always have someone to play with. We love them, the companionship, caring for them and playing with them.

They all have different personalities. Poppy is the most confident and loves her food. Pluto is very placid and enjoys being picked up and cuddled. Pippa is a confident little thing and will let you know if she wants some attention—and when she doesn't!

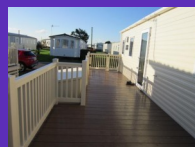

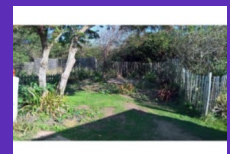


The caravan is 12 ft x 36 ft and benefits from having central heating and double glazing, an en-suite to the main bedroom and a separate bathroom with shower.
